

WHAT AM I BEING ASKED TO CONSIDER?

A Capital Campaign raises the same question for every FLPC household.

How Much Should I Give?

- 1. Please pray for this effort. James 5:16 reminds us: "The prayer of the righteous is powerful and effective."
- 2. Seek to follow the Apostle Paul's advice to the Corinthian Church: "Each one must do as he has made up his mind, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver." (II Cor. 9:7) It is the prayer of the Capital Campaign Committee that your participation in the campaign will be an occasion for joy and not an occasion for discouragement.
- 3. We invite those who are able, to make their commitment out of your accumulated resources. Traditionally, these gifts are given out of long-term savings, appreciated stock, marketable properties, etc. If you are able and feel called to do so, please plan to participate by making a gift out of your accumulated resources.
- 4. We recognize that not everyone has accumulated resources. Many households live from paycheck to paycheck. If this is your situation, we ask that you consider a sacrificial response that is in the range of 2 times your annual pledge. This amount would be paid out over three years, July 1, 2021 June 30, 2024.

Example:

Annual Pledge of \$3000 x 2 = \$6000 total pledge over 3 years = \$2000 per year

5. We realize that some households will be unable to make a response that is 2 times the amount of your annual pledge. Others will feel unable to make any commitment at this time. Please don't concern yourself. Pledge at the level you can and join us in giving thanks to God for all who are called to join in making firm our Church's Foundation. We will welcome spontaneous gifts made at any time during the campaign. If you cannot make a pledge, simply return your Pledge Form and indicate your decision not to participate at this time. We ask that everyone return the Form, those who indicate a financial commitment as well as those who do not.
